A Guide to Connecting to UniDesktop on your Android Device



UniDesktop for Android

UniDesktop is a service that enables you to access software and a university desktop from home. The first time you access UniDesktop on your Android device, you will need to install the ‘Quest vWorkspace Connector’.

This guide shows you how to install the ‘connector’.



UniDesktop for Android

1. Access Google Play on your android device and do a search for 'vWorkspace'. The software is distributed by Quest Software Inc.




2. Download and install the vWorkspace application on your device. Once installed you should see the installed application on your device.

3. Launch the application and keep pressing next until you reach this screen.....





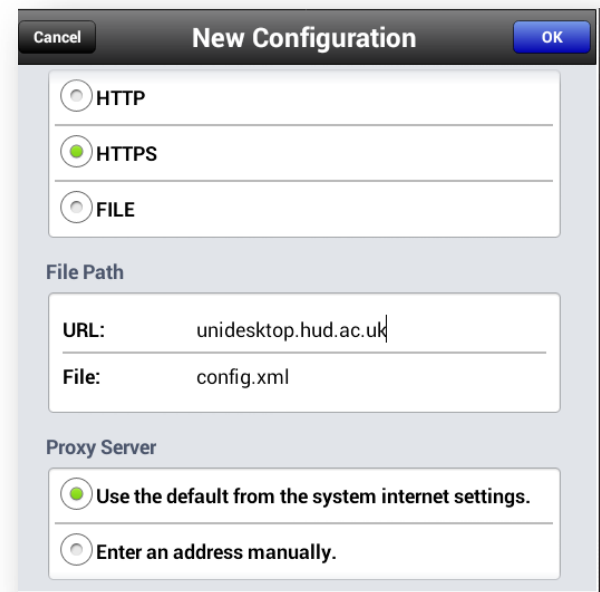

4. Click the  icon to start and then select 'Add vWorkspace Farm..'

5. Select the 'Download Configuration Tool'.



6. Ensure HTTPS is selected and enter the URL **unidesktop.hud.ac.uk** and click OK.

7. Insert the following details:

- Broker Name/IP: UniDesktop.hud.ac.uk
- Your University Username and Password
- Domain: AD
- Tick 'Save Credentials'

8. Click **Connect** in the top right corner.

9. Once logged in, you should see a screen like the one below.



11. In the 'UniDesktop' folder you can access a full virtual desktop. Just double click on the UniDesktop icon.

10. In the 'My Applications' folder there are applications for you to use such as Word, Excel and PowerPoint.
