1. Accessibility Commitment

2. Guidelines and Standards

ISL endeavours to ensure Achiever conforms to Web Content Accessibility Guidelines version 2.1 AA (WCAG 2.1) standard. To help as many people as possible to be able to use Achiever you should be able to:

- navigate most of Achiever using just a keyboard
- zoom in without text spilling off the screen
- use assistive technologies such as screen readers and screen magnifiers

3. Exceptions

Whilst ISL strive to make sure Achiever adheres to WCAG 2.1 standard and guidelines, this is not always possible. Older versions of Achiever released prior to ISL committing to WCAG 2.1 conformance, will not be fully compliant. Newer versions of Achiever will also include some content that is not yet fully compliant. However, ISL remains committed to becoming WCAG 2.1 compliant and making sure that as many people can use Achiever as possible. Improvements in accessibility conformance is a core feature in the Achiever product road map and where constraints prevent customers upgrading to a more recent version of Achiever, custom options are available to improve accessibility usage for specific content.
